#### WHAT WE DO.

Our key procurement services include:

- Procurement Support: Offering in-council
  procurement support and advice to councils
  needing extra capacity or capability. We
  develop plans and strategies to identify the best
  approaches, including single or multi-stage
  tender processes like registrations of interest,
  requests for quotes, or requests for proposals.
- 2. Joint procurement: Facilitating the procurement of goods and services for councils. We engage with councils to understand their needs, then with the market to explore offerings. We develop strategies, manage tender and evaluation processes, and allow councils to opt into joint procurements that meet their requirements.
- Contract Management: Managing a portfolio of joint contracts with suppliers, allowing councils to opt-in as needed. These contracts leverage collective scale, reduce duplication, and ensure consistent processes.
- 4. Panels: Operating two panels, the Professional Services Panel (PSP), our most significant joint procurement arrangement, and the Legal Services Panel, to provide specialised procurement support in these areas.
